

### **CONSTRUCTION AT U42**

The apron east of the north hangar and south of the corporate hangars at South Valley Regional Airport will be replaced this summer.

The project is scheduled to start May 12 and will be completed by June 25.

Construction will not impede ground operations nor curtail access to general aviation hangar rows A – D.

### **U42 PLANE WASH OPEN**

The coin operated plane wash at South Valley Regional Airport (U42) is open.

The plane wash will not be available May 12 through June 25 due to apron construction.

### **SLC GENERAL AVIATION T-HANGAR REPAIRS**

Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) maintenance personnel will perform annual maintenance and repairs to T-hangar doors on general aviation hangars at Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) starting the fourth week of May and estimate completion by the end of June. This will only impact T-hangars on the East Side of Salt Lake International. Repairs at South Valley Regional Airport (U42) will be conducted later this summer.

### **GA T-HANGAR INSPECTIONS SCHEDULED**

General aviation T-hangar inspections will be conducted at Salt Lake City International (SLC) and South Valley Regional (U42) Airports during the month of May. Please check your fire extinguishers inspection dates, drip pans, lease agreements, and other hangar items for compliance.

### **HANGAR BADGE SPONSOR RESPONSIBILITY**

General aviation hangar leases provide for a limited number of active access badges at no charge. Individual hangar lease agreements authorize two (2) badges at no cost while flying club hangar leases allow up to ten (10) badges. Additional badges cost \$25 per badge. Please remember this policy as Airport Badging will charge accordingly before processing any badge applications over the limit. Returned badges do not count toward the total amount of badges authorized.

### **NON-RETURNED HANGAR BADGE POLICY**

Due to ongoing security issues with non-returned airport access badges, the Salt Lake City Department of Airports (SLCDA) now requires T-hangar tenants to pay a \$100 charge for non-returned access badges. Failure to return badges generally occurs when tenants vacate hangars.

Hangar deposit money will be used to pay the fee if badges are not returned within thirty (30) days of vacating the hangar. After that time, deposit refunds can be issued for non-expired badges returned to the Airport.

### **TVY SKYDIVE ACTIVITY**

The skydiving season at the Tooele Valley Airport (TVY) is in full swing.

Exercise extra vigilance when conducting operations at TVY from sunrise through sunset daily. Since TVY is a non-towered airfield, listen for and make advisory calls on the Unicom frequency.

### **INTERNATIONAL LEARN TO FLY DAY AT U42**

On Saturday, May 17, Leading Edge Aviation (LEA) at South Valley Regional Airport (U42) will host its annual International Learn to Fly Day and Armed Forces Day celebration.

\$99 Discovery Flights will be offered and other activities include a BBQ, door prizes, a bounce house, and refreshments from 11:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

### **PROTE CHAMBER COMING TO U42**

On May 16-18 the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) will bring a PROTE (portable reduced oxygen training enclosure) to Leading Edge Aviation (LEA) at South Valley Regional Airport (U42).

Up to 180 pilots may experience the effects of the chamber during the event and the FAA will put on several classes each day including spatial disorientation and physiology of flight.

### AIRCRAFT SELF-FUELING CLARIFICATION

Self-fueling permits are not required when fueling from commercial self-serve pump facilities. Self-fueling permits *are required* to transfer fuel from a container into one's aircraft (i.e. unleaded auto fuel, etc. from a five gallon fuel can).
