



U42 Runway Scheduled to Close on July 10 Between 07:00L and 19:00L

South Valley Regional Airport runway 16/34 will close between 07:00L and 19:00L on Monday, July 10 for application of permanent paint markings.

The current markings on the runway were applied with a temporary paint. Asphalt emits gases for the first 30 days after yellow paint has been laid. The July 10 application will be with a high visibility paint that will last longer.

This is the last component of the runway 16/34 overlay and taxiway re-design project. The \$3 million project involved laying 20,000 tons of asphalt material, using 4,500 cubic yards of engineered fill material and applying 170,000 square feet of paint.

Please remember construction can be delayed by weather or material issues. Tenants are encouraged to monitor NOTAMs for the most current and up to date information concerning construction impacts.

Hangar Inspections Completed in June

Hangar inspections were completed at Salt Lake International Airport (SLC) and South Valley Regional Airport (U42) in June. Hangars were inspected by representatives of Airport Operations and Airport Properties.

Improperly inspected or out of date fire extinguishers were the most common problem. Airport lease requirements dictate that each hangar be equipped with at least a 20BC fire extinguisher, which has to be inspected by a state certified fire extinguisher inspector each year. Those violating the requirement will receive a notice to comply.

Banner Towing at South Valley Regional Between July 15-17

Use caution between July 15 and 17 when banner towing operations will be underway at South Valley Regional Airport.

Banner operations will commence at 18:00L and end at 20:00L each evening. Banner pick-up and drop-off will occur in the field east of runway 16/34.
